We assure you that they are reliable and responsible individuals who are eager to share their unique experiences with your family.

During their stay, our shlichim will engage with your family by swapping stories about life, spending time with your child, and playing with them. They may even share new recipes for you to try! We believe that their presence in your home will bring a wonderful and unforgettable experience to your family.

Please remember that our shlichim are guests in your home and are expected to abide by your family rules. They will clean up after themselves to ensure that your home remains in good condition. There will also be some times when the shlichim will be away from your home as they become friends with other camp staff and join them for outings, shopping, and meals. Please note that all expenses for these activities will be paid for by the shlichim themselves.
