



## Viewing Camp Shalom Photos This Summer

We know that you love to see your child having fun at camp, which is why we have an online photo gallery where you can view pictures of campers in action.

Campsite allows us to have a one stop shop regarding camp needs. This includes access to photos at camp and **facial recognition** to take your camp photos to the next level!

In order for a camper to be recognized by the facial recognition system, CampSite uses the camper's profile photo as a "reference photo".

**All families who registered for camp before Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup> will need to re-upload a photo to toggle ON the facial recognition on your account.**

To get the most out of the facial recognition feature, please see below for the best practices to make your viewing easier.

What makes a good profile photo?

- The camper is the only person in the photo
- The photo is taken with the camper looking straight at the camera
- The background contains contrast to your campers face
- Lighting should be consistent across the photos (no shadows)
- If your camper has a specific identifier, like glasses or braces, they should be present in the profile picture
- **IMPORTANT:** The reference photo should be taken from the second half of the school year to ensure that the profile photo best resembles your camper for this summer

#### **How to upload a profile picture:**

- Log into your CampSite account and select “Enrollment” from the left hand panel.

- You should be able to view your children’s profiles.
- Double click on the current photo. This will prompt you to your saved photos.
- Select a photo that meets the facial recognition criteria.
- Edit the Placement and zoom of the photo and then select “Upload Image”.

#### **How to view and access photos on CampSite:**

- Log into your campsite account and on the left hand panel, click on “Camp Today”.
- This page is where you will find the photo albums of our daily camp photo posts. The most recent albums will show up towards the top of the photo feed.
- The top panel on this page allows you to filter through the albums based on camp hashtags, date of upload, or photos you have bookmarked along the way.
- The second box is where you will be notified if a camper is recognized via the facial recognition feature.  
**To ensure you are notified via email when your child is detected in a camp photo, please make sure you have this box checked.**
